

Here is some more information that you may find useful.



Reading at Home/ Homework

The expectation in Class 2 is that you support your child in their reading by means of hearing your child read every day. Reading little and often (around 10 minutes a day) and focusing on: sounding out unfamiliar words, checking the meanings of words and checking for overall understanding of what has happened are all great ways to help your child with their reading. Each time you read together please write a comment in their reading diary. Books are changed as and when needed. Your child will also receive spellings on a weekly basis. We dedicate two lessons on spellings in school each week, so children become familiar with the rules or similarities given to them. The expectation is on continuing the learning of their spellings at home. Periodically, your child may be given other homework however this will be clearly stuck into their homework diary and they will be given ample time to complete this. This could include comprehension, maths or a project.

Thursday Afternoons

The class teacher on a Thursday afternoon will be Mrs Mammatt. She is an Art and Design Technology specialist and so she will be taking these two subjects (and RE) throughout the year.
