Art

Maths

EYFS: Alive in 5, length and capacity, shape, building 7, 8, 9.

Y1: Place value, addition and subtraction to 20, length and height, mass and volume.

Y2: Money, multiplication and division, length and height.

Geography

We will focus upon an indepth look at both global and local areas, exploring the key question: Where does our food come from and why does it matter?

RE

We will look at Passover in the first half of Spring and explore How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do? We will also cover the Easter Story in the second half of the term.

RSE

During the Spring term we will focus on Safety. We will look at Computer Safety and also hazards within our homes and keeping ourselves safe.

Science

This term we will begin by looking at animals including humans, and homes and habitats.

Identifying, classifying and observational skills will be taught and used.

Science week will feature a week of investigations and fun!

History

This term we focus on an events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally. We will look at the significance of Pompeii and the Roman Empire.

PE

This term, PE wil be on a <u>Tuesday</u>. We will be based in the hall and will be focusing on team games; developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.
